



REQUIREMENTS FOR REPORT OF MARRIAGE

(Marriage contracted outside the Philippines)

1. Five (5) original duly accomplished Report of Marriage forms (if applying by mail, forms must be notarized)
2. Original and five (5) copies of Marriage Contract (*with appropriate English text in Hungary, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Republic of Bulgaria, Republic of Moldova, Montenegro, Romania, and Republic of Serbia (If document is not in English, kindly have the document translated into English and have the translation notarized.)*)
 - a. Original or certified true copy and five (5) copies of PSA issued birth certificate of the Filipino/a spouse
 - b. Original or certified true copy and five (5) copies of Birth Certificate of foreign spouse
 - c. Five (5) photocopies of data page of both husband and wife passports
 - d. Photo ID of both husband and wife
 - e. If applicable, certified copy of death certificate of previous husband, or annulment papers from previous husband or divorce papers filed by the previous husband (if husband is a foreigner).

NOTE: Currently, there is no divorce law in the Philippines. All foreign divorce decrees or annulments obtained abroad should be first recognized by an appropriate Philippine Court to take effect in the Philippines.

Additional Requirements:

1. If Filipino spouse was previously married and divorced, or previously married and marriage was subsequently annulled:
 - One (1) original or certified true copy and four (4) copies of the Judicial Decree of Divorce or Annulment
2. If Filipino spouse is a widow/widower:
 - One (1) original or certified true copy and four (4) copies of Death Certificate of deceased spouse

ONLY marriages contracted in the following places can be registered or reported at the Philippine Embassy in Budapest:

1. *Hungary*
2. *Romania*
3. *Bulgaria*
4. *Serbia*
5. *Bosnia-Herzegovina*
6. *Montenegro*
7. *Moldova*

Processing fee is \$25.
